UNESCO TWAS-CASAREP invites nominations from early level Mid Career Scientists having regular positions in their country in Science and Technology/ Institutions/ Universities/ Organizations in any field (Basic or Applied Science). The Regional Partner encourages more nominations from Women Scientists from developing countries particularly from LDCs and S&T Lagging countries

The nominations should be recommended by a Fellow of TWAS/Head of the Institutions/Head of the Department. **The nominee should have been living and working in a developing country for at least past 3 years.** The work done in their own country will be the basis for the consideration of the award. If part or whole of work has been done outside their country, the extent of work done in their country may kindly be indicated. Candidate should have 10 or more research publications in the referred journals.

Age criteria:

The selection of TWAS Young Affiliates is open to Scientists of aged 40 or less as on 1 January of the year in which they are selected
